





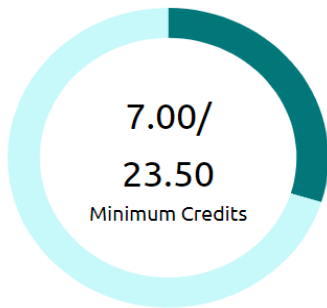

## ▶ **Regional Career Pathways**

- ▶ Central District 301 has partnered with District 300, District 303, and District U-46 to provide regional career pathways that will be open to students across districts. These pathways will lead to a certification for students that they can carry directly into the workplace. For the 2018-2019 school year, students can enroll in the following programs:

- ▶ **Veterinary Science (housed in District 301)**

- ▶ **Welding (housed in District 300 and U-46)**

- ▶ **Precision Manufacturing (housed in U-46)**

- ▶ Must enter in as sophomores

- ▶ Transportation is provided by CHS

# TRADE/TECH PROGRAMS

- ▶ Advanced Placement is a program run by the College Board that allows a student to take courses here at CHS, which can earn you college credit and/or qualify you for more advanced classes when you begin college.
- ▶ AP exam at end of the year
- ▶ After taking the PSAT the AP Potential report is generated and predicts if your student might be successful in AP classes. Discussed during course selection meetings with counselors
- ▶ Reach out to your students counselor for discussing appropriate course placements.

# ADVANCED PLACEMENT

## ▶ **Is it the right fit for me?**

- ▶ Blended Learning is a great opportunity to challenge yourself and to experience a non-traditional way of learning, but it isn't for every student.
- ▶ It pairs quality instruction from a teacher with the use of technology and the freedom to attend class in a non traditional way using Canvas.
- ▶ Helps prepare students for a college environment

**BLENDED LEARNING**



- ▶ ECC offers both a Full time and Part time pathway option for both juniors and seniors.
- ▶ **Full time:** students will be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours per semester.
- ▶ **Part time:** student will enroll in 2-3 college courses each semester. Courses are selected from a variety of academic disciplines, including general education (i.e., English, math, history, science, etc.) and career and technical education (CTE) programs (i.e. automotive, culinary arts, paralegal, etc.).
- ▶ Transportation is not provided by CHS as student must drive themselves to and from ECC.
- ▶ Must meet qualifications.
