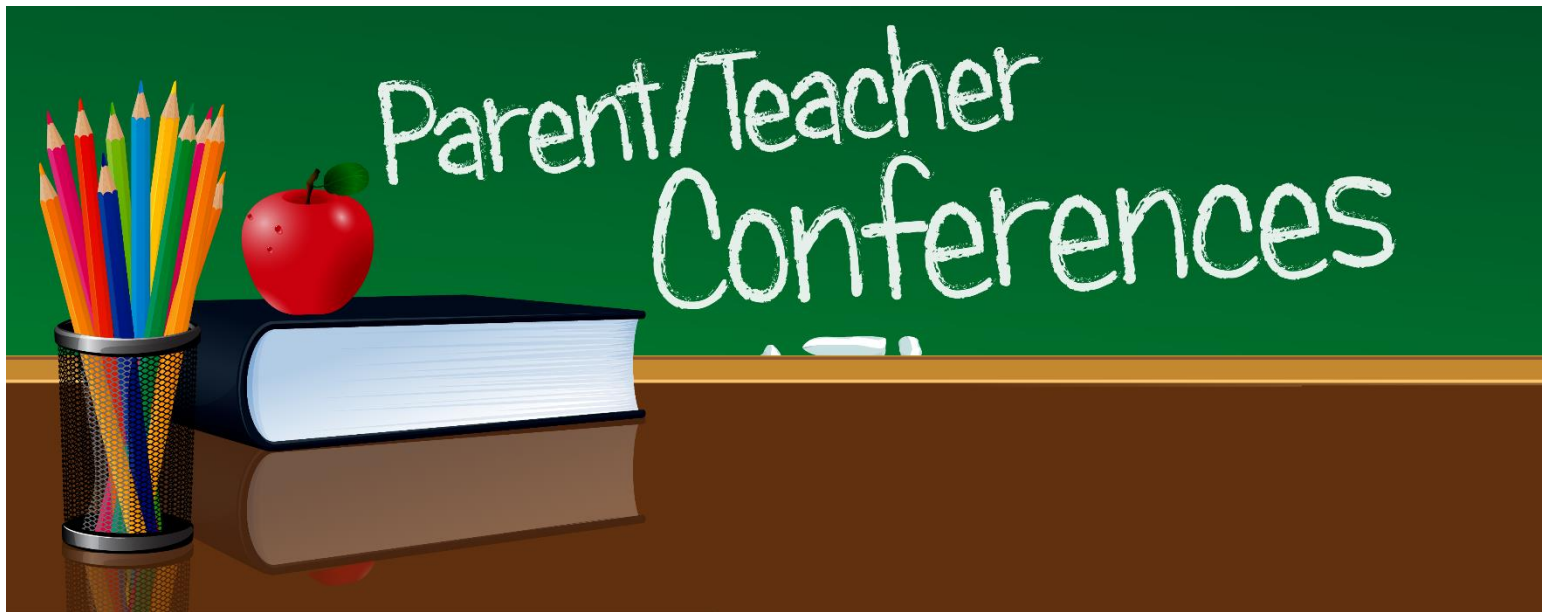

The 2019-2020 school year will be upon us before you know it. Please log into the Parent Portal (accessible on the main district webpage) to complete the registration process. In the portal, you will be able to update parent contact phone numbers and e-mails, as well as emergency contact information. You will also be able to pay your student's school fees.

If you have made a residence move, you will not be able to update that information in Skyward. Please contact the High School office to prove residency. Any families who have moved, are hosted, or rent can start the residency process May 1st.

The due date for registration fees is June 30th. Students who have outstanding fees or whose residency is not established will not be able to purchase a parking permit (for those students who qualify), participate in behind the wheel driving, nor participate in athletic competitions.
